Three years of the Scandinavian-Polish Chamber of Commerce in West Pomerania

On 19th April three new companies received certificates of membership of the Scandinavian-Polish Chamber of Commerce. One of them was <u>Eltwin Sp. z o.o., a</u> <u>Danish producer of electronic goods</u>, encouraged to invest in Szczecin by the Investors' Assistance Center in November 2010.

A certificate of membership also went to Magnus Isaksson from Realkapital Szczecin Sp. z o. o., which is the developer responsible for the construction of *Piastów Office Centre*, an office building in the region's capital. The investment has been planned for completion in November this year. The new facility will expand the city's office capacity by 18 thousand m². The third new member of the SPCC is the Interglobus Travel Agency, the leading Szczecin carrier known for its uniformly-marked vehicle fleet *Follow me*. With these companies, the Szczecin branch of the Scandinavian-Polish Chamber of Commerce comprises 44 members, consolidating its position as the second most numerous branch in Poland (after Warsaw).

On the third anniversary of the SPCC, the Westpomeranian Region was represented by the Deputy Marshal, Andrzej Jakubowski. The event attracted several dozen guests to the Radisson Blu hotel in Szczecin - mainly members of the Chamber's Westpomeranian branch. A substantial contribution in the form of a presentation on the current macroeconomic standing of Europe and the world was provided by Nordea and Deloitte. Carsten Nilsen, Chairman of SPCC's Management Board, and Kaare Nordbø, Regional Representative of the SPCC in Szczecin, summed up the activities of the SPCC in Poland and West Pomerania.

I asked the Chairman which region he found most pleasant to cooperate with. - Deputy Marshal Jakubowski revealed in his conversation with Carsten Nilsen. I got the answer I had hoped for - with West Pomerania.
