

NORWEGIAN SECTION OF SPCC ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2010.

In respect of the above, please note the following:

1) During the Year 2010 the Norwegian Section of the Scandinavian Polish Chamber of Commerce (SPCC) was engaged in a limited number of activities, the main reason for this being that SPCC has taken over nearly all activities such as Business Mixers, Lunch and Breakfast Meetings with attending Speakers of distinction.

2) The activities organized by the Norwegian Section have therefore been of a social nature, the objective being to make it possible for Members to meet socially and on an informal basis, the Events which have taken place being as follows:

28th of February 2010: AGM for 2010 and Business Lunch, the said lunch being paid by the SPCC allocation.

27th of April 2010: Business Lunch, the said lunch being paid by Members attending and partially by the SPCC allocation.

29th of May 2010: "Eurovision Song Contest", the said event was a great success and well attended by both Norwegian and other Members of SPCC. The event was paid by those attending as well as by companies sponsoring this "One Off Event" which was awarded 10 points by those participating.

24th of November 2010: Business Lunch, the said lunch being paid by Members attending and partially by the SPCC allocation.

11th of December 2010: "Julebord", following the great success of this event last year the Board decided to establish the "Julebord" as a permanent annual event in December of each year.


The "Julebord" was attended by some 60 persons, more than 2/3 being Members of the Norwegian Section and the comments from the participants were again very positive. The event was funded by individual payments, a contribution from the SPCC allocation as well as donations and prizes given by many member companies.

3) All the above events with the exception of the "Eurovision Song Contest" were attended by the Norwegian Ambassador, H.E. Enok Nygaard and the Board is extremely grateful for the support and encouragement given by the Embassy in respect of the various activities undertaken in 2010.

4) At the end of 2010 a total of 41 companies and individuals were registered in the Norwegian Section of SPCC.

5) The Norwegian Section of SPCC was allocated a budget of PLN 14,000 for the Year 2010 and this amount was used to fund the events as mentioned in Section of this Report.
