

Investor-Friendly Poland”. Survey and call for ideas

The Polish Information and Foreign Investment Agency (PAIIZ) is launching a survey - “Investor-Friendly Poland” which is a unique opportunity to contribute ideas for quick win improvements that can make life easier for foreigners doing business in Poland.

The project, organized under the Honorary Patronage of Ministry of Economy, is an initiative of PAIIZ, Pytlak & Tymendorf Law Office and Polish innovation consulting firm Innovatika. Its ambitious goal is not only to describe the challenges, but also engage key stakeholders in selecting and implementing best improvement ideas in the field of legal business environment.

The project starts with a short, 7-question **survey for foreigners doing business in Poland**, aiming to collect stories of success and areas for improvement in the Polish legal environment connected with business. The organizers want to define difficulties most often encountered by businesspersons from abroad but also get to know their opinion about changes which have been taking place in the sphere in Poland over last years. The deadline for completing the survey is **September 30th, 2010.**

A complementary crowdsourcing forum allows anyone to **submit, comment and vote for new ideas** for quick-win improvements that would make Poland a friendly place for foreigners doing business.
