

Import- Export

From the officially available materials, we have the data published by GUS in the last days of August. They cover the period between January and December 2015.

According to them (with the Scandinavian region understood as 4 different countries; DK, FI, NO, SE):

- In 2015 the level of mutual trade between Poland and Scandinavian countries exceeded the value of 11,7 billion EUR in export and 9,1 billion EUR in the import category.
- It means that in 2015 the annual trade turnover between Poland and Scandinavia reached the value of 20,9 billion EUR
- The highest exchange values still involve Sweden (with total balance at over 1,6 billion EUR and, what is important, as we predicted in our last SPCC report the mutual trading volume exceeded 8 billion EUR for the first time)

The summary/ extract from GUS's data is presented in the table below, and the full GUS report is available in the attached PDF file (tables on p.63-64). There they also show the dynamics of those turnovers in regard to specific countries and compare them to 2014 figures.
