The Annual General Meeting of the Finnish Trade Guild approved unanimously on January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011 a resolution addressed to the SPCC Board, encouraging the Board to investigate possibilities for SPCC to introduce legal advice services to members, similarly to what many Chambers of Commerce have traditionally done in the Nordic countries.

I am pleased to inform that SPCC has now introduced such a service as of May, available to all SPCC members except individual members. The service is included in the membership fee and confidential advice is provided in cooperation with and by Warsaw based law firm Smolarek, Rogala, Caban.
